



## ... Using Win10's Notepad as a 'plain text' editor for PWP8 scripts ...

Setup: Open Notepad and click on Format:

- (1) Check Word Wrap and
- (2) Select Arial Unicode MS from the Font list.
- (3) Select OK.....These changes will be retained when Notepad is next opened.

## Using Notepad to read or edit PWP8 saved script parameters:

(1) Click-Hold-Drag-Release Notepad's lower right window frame corner: down and left; making parameters appear as lines for easier identification and editing.



## File \ Save As...:

- (1) Change Save as type from Text Documents (\*.txt) to All Files (\*.\*). This will allow adding PWP8 Setting file extensions (\*.script; \*.workspace; etc.) to the File name
- (2) Change Encoding from ANSI to UTF-8
- (3) Select Save.....(1) and (2) may need to be performed each time the Save as... window is used.
